Dear Homeowner:

The Montgomery County Department of Transportation adopted a policy that allows residents the option to replace deteriorated driveway aprons while Montgomery County's Rehabilitation Program is performed in your neighborhood.

The driveway apron is generally considered the area from the curb to the front edge of the sidewalk or to the property line. (Please see the reverse side of this page for a diagram of a driveway apron). Since the apron benefits only the homeowner and not the general public, County policy requires that the homeowner be responsible for the maintenance of the apron. As a result of the policy, it has been determined that your apron qualifies you to exercise this replacement option. These services are provided by a private contractor at the County contract price while working in your neighborhood.

There are two benefits to the homeowner when exercising this option. First, the homeowner benefits from the competitive pricing resulting from an open government procurement process as reflected in the contract unit prices; the current unit price is **\$35.39** per square yard. Second, this work is under the purview of County inspection staff, therefore no separate permit is required. Should you elect to exercise this option, contact the inspector overseeing the construction work for the County at _____ and leave a message on his voice-mail. The message should state your **name, address, daytime telephone, and a time you can be reached**. You should also mention whether our inspectors should leave an estimate on your door, should meet with you in person or should contact you by telephone. **Please call within five (5) days from the above date, to make the above arrangements.**

East Bethesda residents wishing to elect to exercise this option should contact, Ian Prophet 240-778-9997 (cell), when you see MCDOT begin work on your street.
